

## Cookies Policy

1. **What are cookies?** Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer, a smartphone or other mobile device by websites that you visit or a browser. They are widely used in order to enable tracking of an individual's browsing or website activity, to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the site. A cookie will usually contain the name of the website from which the cookie has come from, the 'lifetime' of the cookie (i.e. how long the cookie will remain on your device) and generating a random UID for each visitor on the first time they come.
2. **How are cookies used?** Cookies are used to identify browsing behaviour of a visitor to the site, i.e. how the visitor uses the website and enable him/her to move around the website and use its features. They are also used to remember the preferences of any returning visitors to the site, which can be used by website owners to deliver more enhanced, more personal content. All data provided by the visitor to our website or any automatically compiled aggregate data about the site traffic and interaction are used in order to:
  - a. improve how our website works, site security, reliability and functionality,
  - b. session tracking,
  - c. enable site owners to provide targeted content, i.e. personalise User's browsing experience to match his/her preferences or choices,
  - d. analyse, compile statistics and track performance records on the website.
3. **What types of cookies do we use?** The [www.oxygenetic.pl](http://www.oxygenetic.pl) web page, hereinafter the 'Website', uses the following cookies:
  - a. Strictly necessary cookies (session cookies) - these cookies enable you to move around our website and use its features, such as accessing secure areas of the website.
  - b. Functionality cookies (performance and persistent cookies) - these cookies are saved on the device of the visitor to the site and are used to remember website settings to enable the website owner to provide personalised user browsing experience. The lifetime of cookies is defined by your settings for the website or remain on the device until deleted by the User by clearing browsing history of his/her browser.
  - c. Third Party Cookies (targeting and advertising cookies) - these cookies enable, inter alia, to identify preferences of a site visitor and are used to display targeted advertising to web visitors across a broad range of other websites placed by advertising networks or affiliates with our permission. They are also used to track traffic on the Website.
4. **How to restrict or block cookies?**

By default, browsing software enables placing cookies on your device. At any time visitor to websites may change browser settings. If you wish to restrict or block the cookies which are set automatically by our website, or indeed any other website, or to consent each time under privacy and security settings for cookies to be placed on your device, you can do this through your browser settings. The 'Settings' within your browser should tell you how. However, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies (including strictly necessary cookies) you may not be able to access all or parts of our site. Unless you have adjusted your browser setting so that it will refuse cookies, our system will issue cookies as soon you visit our site.

#### **5. What else should you know about cookies?**

Cookies are used on this website to automatically collect information on how you use the site. Most web browsers are set to accept cookies. When you visit <https://oxygenetic.pl/> our servers along with Google Analytics, Facebook, HotJar, Megiteam and other third party programs track and record information that your browser sends. This data may include: your IP address, browser type, operating system, web pages viewed, product viewed, referring sites, time spent on site, product purchase information and other statistics relating to browsing behaviours. By using our website, you agree that we can place these type of cookies on your computer/other device for the purpose set out in our cookies policy.
