

Privacy Policy

Aflofarm Farmacja Polska Sp. z o.o. (“we/us”) recognises the importance of your privacy, and that you have a right to control how your personal information is collected and used. We know that providing personal information is an act of trust and we take that seriously.

We have provided this notice to you to describe our information collection and use practices at Aflofarm Farmacja Polska Sp. z o.o. This notice also describes the choices you can make about the way your information is collected, used, and shared. The notice applies to any cookies collected by us through the use of this Website and any other interactions with us as described below.

Definitions:

Website - web page with the URL www.oxygenetic.pl

User – a visitor to the website, web address www.oxygenetic.pl

Website Owner – the proprietor of the web page at the URL www.oxygenetic.pl - Aflofarm Farmacja Polska Sp. z o.o., organised and existing under the laws of Poland, seated at Partyzancka 133/151, 95-200 Pabianice, entered into the Register of Entrepreneurs of the National Court Register by the District Court for Łódź-Śródmieście XX Commercial Division with the KRS number 0000014115, share capital PLN 26,271,500.00, NIP: 731-18-21-205, REGON: 472871255, hereinafter also referred to as the “Aflofarm”.

Collecting information about you

1. Unless you directly give us consent to do otherwise, we will only collect and use your personal information as set out below in our Privacy Policy. The Data Controller of your personal data shall be Aflofarm Farmacja Polska Sp. z o.o.
2. Your personal data shall be processed by the Data Controller for the compliance with a legal obligation to which the Controller is subject under Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (the General Data Protection Regulation or ‘GDPR’).
3. When you visit our website, we may collect cookies that can be used to identify you as an individual. The type of information we collect from you depends on how you use our website.

This data may include:

- a. information on how you use our website, including your IP address, pages viewed, product viewed, time spent on site other statistics relating to browsing behaviours;
- b. technical information of devices used by the visitor to access our site and other technical data;
- c. session recordings of mouse clicks, movement, web pages or items viewed;
- d. any other data that a site visitor provides electronically via our contact form or email.

Processing

All data provided by the User via email (email address itself may contain information that is deemed to be personal data) can be processed by Aflofarm:

- a. to reply to your enquiry/submission regarding products, collaboration or operations of Aflofarm subject to the prior consent of the User to any such processing or where the purpose of the processing of personal data is determined in the legal basis for the compliance with the applicable regulations on proviso that, at all times, the processing of personal data collected or obtained by the controller shall be limited solely to the legitimate interest pursued by the Data Controller;
- b. for complaint handling - the legitimate interest of the Data Controller – pursuant to Art. 6 item 1 (f) GDPR.

6. Providing personal data to the Controller is voluntary, yet failure to do so may impede or make it impossible to handle your inquiries. The processing of personal data may be carried out for the legitimate interest of Aflofarm which overrides the legitimate interest and rights of the User. Should the legitimate interest pursued by Aflofarm for the processing of personal data fail to override the legitimate interest of the User, any such processing of personal data provided by the User shall be carried out in compliance with the respective legal basis at all times to the extent required by law. Then, any such mandatory personal data may be stored for the purpose of compliance with legal obligations. The lifetime of personal data storage depends on the type of personal information obtained or collected by the Controller. Aflofarm represents to maintain any personal data for as long it is necessary or required to achieve for the purpose set out in this Privacy Policy. After that time Aflofarm shall delete or anonymise any such personal data of the User. Should it be impossible to do so (for instance personal data have been saved in the backup archives), then the personal data will be re-identified, encrypted or pseudonymised for further processing until deleted on proviso that it is lawful and technically possible.

7. The recipients of personal data of the User shall be (1) appointed employees of Aflofarm and authorised persons of third parties contracted by Aflofarm and (2) entities acting for or on behalf of Aflofarm, i.e. external providers of telecommunication services (providers of telecommunication infrastructure, mailbox (webmail services), computer system used by Aflofarm) (3) authorities, agencies or other governmental bodies or third parties as required under the applicable regulations (4) chartered accountant or other professionals.

8. In case the processing of personal data is carried out based on the User's consent, the User may withdraw any such consent for the processing of personal data without the prejudice to the foregoing lawfulness of the processing.

Subscription/newsletters

9. By visiting our Website you consent to receiving marketing or advertising material which is an integral part of the Website. The integral part shall also include online banners where Aflofarm can advertise its services and provide you with updated information about product offering or other information about our products and services which you may enjoy.

Access to information, changing and deleting information we hold

10. At any time, you have the right to rectify, delete, limit the processing, the right to data portability (transfer) or right to object to processing. If at any time you wish to change personal information that is inaccurate or out of date, please contact us by e-mailing us at daneosobowe@aflofarm.pl and we will amend this record or take all reasonable steps to delete it unless we need to keep it for legal reasons. If you think your data protection rights have been breached, you can lodge a complaint with Polish Data Protection Authority – the President of the Personal Data Protection Office in Poland.

Changes to this policy

11. From time to time, our policies will be reviewed and may be revised. We reserve the right to change our Privacy Policy at any time and notify you by posting an updated version of the policy on our website.

12. Any matters not covered by this Privacy Policy shall be construed and governed by the applicable law.
